



**NOTICE OF SEPTEMBER 14, 2021  
CALIFORNIA GUBERNATORIAL RECALL ELECTION**

Notice is hereby given that a statewide Special Election will be held on September 14, 2021 to determine whether Gavin Newsom, Governor of the State of California, shall be recalled, and if the majority vote on the question is to recall, to elect a successor.

Pursuant to Election Code §3000.5, all Californians who are registered, active and otherwise eligible to vote in the September 14, 2021 California Gubernatorial Recall Election shall receive a vote-by-mail ballot.

The distribution of vote-by-mail ballots does not prevent a voter from voting in person at a polling place. Polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, September 14, 2021.

Notice is further given that all ballots will be tallied at a central counting center located at the Imperial County Registrar of Voters' Office located in the County Administration Center, 940 West Main Street, Suite 206, El Centro, CA.

Notice is further given, that beginning at 9:00 a.m. on August 16, 2021 vote-by-mail ballots will be processed for counting, pursuant to Election Code §15101.
