The Imperial County Registrar of Voters is hiring Election Poll Workers for the March 5, 2024 Presidential Primary Election. To be a poll worker, you must be one of the following:

- A registered voter in California
- A legal permanent resident of the United States
- A high school student age 16 or order with a 2.5 GPA – Must obtain teacher and parent permission

Selected poll workers must attend a 2-3 hour scheduled training class. A \$15 stipend will be provided for class attendance. Positions currently offered:

Inspector - \$110 per day
