



Notice of California Statewide Direct Primary Election

Notice is hereby given that the following districts will consolidate with the California Statewide Direct Primary Election to be held on June 2, 2026, and that the offices for which candidates may be nominated for said election are as follows:

The qualifications for these offices required under the principal act under which these districts are organized are that candidates be registered electors residing within the boundaries of the districts or divisions thereof.

Declaration of Candidacy for eligible people desiring to file for elective offices will be available at the Registrar of Voters' Office, 940 West Main Street, Suite 206, El Centro, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., commencing February 2, 2026. Declaration of Candidacy must be filed with the Registrar of Voters not before February 9, 2026, and no later than 5:00 p.m. on March 6, 2026.

If a Declaration of Candidacy for any incumbent elective officer of a district is not filed by 5:00 p.m. on March 6, 2026, any person other than the person who was the incumbent on the 88th day shall have until 5:00 p.m. on March 11, 2026, to file a Declaration of Candidacy for the elective office.

Pursuant to Elections Code §3000.5, all Californians who are registered, active and otherwise eligible to vote shall receive a vote-by-mail ballot via the U.S. Postal Service.

The distribution of vote-by-mail ballots does not prevent a voter from voting in person at a Vote Center. Vote Centers will be open beginning May 23, 2026 through June 1, 2026 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and on Election Day, June 2, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Notice is further given all ballots will be tallied at a central counting center located at the Imperial County Registrar of Voters' Office located at the County Administration Center, 940 West Main Street, Suite 206, El Centro, CA.

Notice is further given that beginning at 9:00 a.m. on May 4, 2026 vote-by-mail ballots will be processed for counting, pursuant to Elections Code §15101.
