		Retirement Board request the Board of Supervisors to call for an election.
March 31, 2026 E-56	ROV	<b>Notice of Election</b> ICERS §14 A(2)
		Before this day, the Registrar of Voters (ROV) shall send to each county department, the courts, Imperial County Transportation Commission (ICTC), Imperial County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) and the Imperial County Association of Retired Employees (ICARE) and post in conspicuous places and on the internet, notices stating that nomination petitions are available from the ROV, the number of signatures required and the date of the election.
April 3-17, 2026 E-53 to E-39	Candidate	<b>Nomination Period</b> ICERS §14 A(4)
		Nomination shall be by petition signed by not less than twenty (20) general members. Nomination petitions shall be presented to the ROV no earlier than fifty-three (53) days before the election and no later than 5:00 p.m. thirty-nine (39) days before the election. If an election has been called and only one member nominated, the Board of Supervisors shall order that no election be held and shall appoint the nominee in-lieu of election.

		<p>Each candidate may prepare a statement of qualifications. The statement may include the name, age and occupation of the candidate and a brief description of no more than 200 words of the candidate's education and qualifications. Any cost to file and distribute a candidate's statement will be borne by the candidate and paid to the ROV. The statement must be presented to the ROV no later than 5:00 p.m. thirty-nine (39) days before Election Day.</p>
<p align="center"><b>The Imperial County Employees' Retirement System staff shall determine whether the person named in the petition is a general, safety, or retired member and whether the persons signing the petition are general, safety, or retired members. ICERS §14 A(5)</b></p>		
April 20, 2026 E-36	ROV	<p align="center"><b>Random Alphabet Drawing</b></p>
		<p>The Random Alphabet Drawing to determine the order of candidate names on the ballot will be held at 11:00 a.m. at the ROV Office located at 940 West Main Street, Suite 206, El Centro.</p>
April 22, 2026 E-34	ICERS	<p align="center"><b>Retirement System Staff Prepare List of Members</b></p>
		<p>Retirement System staff shall prepare a list and labels of all persons entitled to vote and shall furnish the list to the ROV on or before thirty-five (35) days before each election. The ROV shall prepare a ballot and provide the ballot proof to the Retirement Administrator for approval.</p>
April 24, 2026 E-32	ROV	<p align="center"><b>Order Ballots</b></p>
		<p>The ROV will order ballots. Ballots shall be ordered as soon as filing period has closed and after random drawing.</p>
<p align="center"><b>There are no provisions for write-in candidates and no write-in votes will be counted. ICERS §14 A(7)</b></p>		
May 4, 2026 E-22	ROV	<p align="center"><b>Voting by Absentee Ballot</b> ICERS §14 A(8)</p>
		<p>The ROV will distribute ballots. Ballots and candidate statements will be mailed to general members. An e-mail notification shall be sent by the ROV to all general members advising them to expect to receive their ballot in the mail.</p>
May 26, 2026 E-Day	ROV	<p align="center"><b>Election Day</b> ICERS §14 A(9)</p>
		<p>Each voter shall return the voted ballot to the ROV no later than 5:00 p.m on Election Day.</p>

DATE	RESPONSIBLE PARTY	DESCRIPTION
May 27, 2026 E+1	ROV	<b>Official Canvass</b> ICERS §14 A(10)
		The Registrar of Voters shall canvass the votes after the election. The Canvass shall be public and made by tallying the vote for each name appearing on the ballot and declaring the results of such tally.
June 2, 2026 E+7	ROV	<b>Certify Results</b>
		The Registrar of Voters shall certify the results of the election at the next regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors following the canvass and declare the person receiving the greatest number of votes to be an elected member of the Board of Retirement.
